10th March 2024 FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT

Reflection

"Light has come into the world, but people loved darkness instead of light because their deeds were evil. ²⁰Everyone who does evil hates the light and will not come into the light, for fear that their deeds will be exposed."

Spiritual darkness = moral blindness where persons habitually hate their fellow human.

Despite the combined light of the full moon and all the visible stars in a cloudless sky, the night does not go. But the moment the sun rises, the night makes a hasty exit." The light of the sun is such that the darkness cannot remain before it. The light of God's knowledge has a similar effect in dispelling the darkness of ignorance. We know that God is "Light".

"For, those whose ignorance is destroyed by divine knowledge, the Supreme Entity is revealed, just as the sun illumines everything when it rises".

Physical darkness is due to the absence of light.

Some people take credit as proponents of darkness and tend to interpret everything as an illusion. If we say that we have fellowship with Him and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not practice the truth and are susceptible to playing of egoistic pursuits. There is a topic that is trending amongst the younger generation as delusions is the solution to all problems. In other words, "delulu is the solulu." We've been at the stage in life where we are confused, left out by society, overwhelmed with sophisticated information, combating stressful data and just overall tired. Out of desperation they conclude: Light leads to sorrow, darkness is bliss.



Most often, darkness is responsible for creating illusions. In the cinema hall, the shades of light falling on the screen creates the illusion of reality, and people get absorbed in watching it. However, when the main lights in the cinema hall are switched on, the illusion is dispelled, and people wake up to their senses to realize that they were only watching a movie. When the light of God's knowledge begins shining brightly, the illusion beats a hasty retreat, and the soul wakes up to its true spiritual identity. God's spiritual energy illumines it with the light of knowledge.

Light emerges from God, John means by "walking in the light" (1:7). *Children of light - Children of love - children of life*, they refuse to say no to sacrifice. We walk in the light. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. He is the eternal light through which we are able to perceive clearly the realities of this world and the kingdom understanding of God as well.
