erman philosopher and non-believer Friedrich Nietzsche, once observed famously about Christianity: 'If you want me to believe in your redeemer, then you've got to look a lot more redeemed.' Some who profess to be Christians believe, mistakenly and sadly, that there is no place for fun or joy in religion. As people of the Resurrection, incurable hopers who keep on believing, trusting and hoping, we are invited to live our faith with a sense of joy and life to the full.


Hope is the radical refusal to put limits on what God can do for us. Pope Francis has told us that Jesus administers 'a therapy of hope'. We have all had difficult moments in life, dark moments in which we walked in sadness, pensive, without horizons, with only a wall before us. And Jesus is always beside us to give us hope, to warm our hearts and to say: "Go ahead, I am with you".

Historian Manning Clark wrote that there were two types of teachers at his school: *Life enlargers*: who gave their students real perspective, and helped them to see the big picture in life. As St Ignatius would say 'helped students see God in all things and all things in God'. And teachers he deemed, *Life straighteners*: narrow people, with little imagination or creativity, whose teaching remained closely confined to the curriculum, without daring to stray into the detours on which good education can thrive.

As Christians we are called to be people of the Resurrection, people who are joyful, and aspire to be life enlargers, ready to spread joy wherever life takes us. (adapted from Fr Chris Gleeson Madonna Magazine 2021)
