This Sunday's Reflection

heodore Roosevelt has the following beautiful advice to all mothers: "Into the woman's keeping is committed the destiny of the generations to come after us. Surely, she who can thus train her sons and her daughters is twice fortunate among women".

On Mother's Day families pay special tribute to their mums in various ways, like giving cards, flowers, breakfast in bed, lunch at a fine restaurant, long-distance calls, and special gifts. These are just some of the ways families will say thanks to Mum, and that is as it should be.

Proverbs 31:10-31 presents us with God's description and estimation of what a godly wife and mother look like. 1. She is a devoted wife. 2. She is one who has the confidence of her husband. 3. She is devoted to the needs of her family. 4. She is well groomed, attractive, organized, and disciplined and as such, is a testimony to her children. 5. She is a woman full of God's wisdom. St. Paul exhorts husbands to love their wives as Christ loves the Church (Ephesians 6: 25). Husbands have the solemn duty to sacrifice themselves continually in their total love for their wives and their children. The most important thing a father can do for his children is to love their mother.

form of fervent prayers before God. But unfortunately, too often Mother's Day is simply a time when families attempt to atone for an entire year of neglect, indifference, misuse, and disrespect towards mothers.

George Washington once said, "My mother was the most beautiful woman I ever saw. All I am, I owe to my mother. I attribute all my success in life to the moral, intellectual, and physical education I received from her." Many gentlemen would say, I should have been turned out badly and notoriously. But her firmness, her sweetness, and her goodness were potential powers to keep me on the right path. My mother was the making of me.

For us Christians, we acknowledge two mothers: our own mothers and Mary, the mother of Jesus, she is the true model of motherhood. She affirmed her obedience to the call of God and lived out her vocation throughout her entire life. As we know a mother is a curious mixture of patience, kindness, understanding, discipline, perseverance, purity, and love; what else?
