Winter Embrace - Greystanes Catholic Community

Dear friends

So many people share our large parish property every day, engaged in the precious activities of our Pre-School, Primary School, College and OLQP Worshipping Parish. It would be wonderful to welcome many more people who belong on the property, to experience a blessed sacramental life. But even before hoping that, how special it is that we have access to so many people and their families, here on the parish hill at Greystanes! What opportunities we have, with enough of us backing it, to build a big sense of unity; a unity in which LOTS more people can at least experience some positive level of being part of God's Church, on mission, making a difference.

That's what the 'Winter Embrace' and 'Christmas Embrace' are about; ideas that only quite recently have begun to be part of our language across our 18 acre parish site.

And so, everyone on the property, in various ways over the current days, is hearing that the goal of our united Embrace theme is threefold:

- To Embrace stories of others' lives and challenges
- To Embrace the human story of service and capacity
- To Embrace projects to make a difference for God's mission



THREE STORIES

This Winter Embrace (from now through to the following weekend) is focussing on three stories:

1. The story of those whose lives are lifted by the St Vincent de Paul Society / Vinnies - including the inspirational beginning story of this huge international work of God's love — by a 20 year old university student in Paris. (We'll celebrate a piece of that story at Masses next weekend)



- 2. The story of 'Project Elizabeth' focussing on something we all once were: Babies! This special work in our Diocese of Parramatta supports people who are pregnant and struggling; people who've had the sadness of losing a baby before or after birth; and people who are finding it tough raising babies through infancy. (The parish has already embraced that story in recent weeks)
- 3. The story of some kids mainly living on plantations in the region of Galle on the south western tip of Sri Lanka. As we did last year, we'll support this region again with school items in places where there are very limited family funds for simple learning tools we would take for granted.

SLEEPOUTS to support Winter Embrace Story 1 above

One of the efforts of both our on-site Primary School and College for the Winter Embrace is next Friday night. Each school will run an overnight sleepout in the cold. As well as raising funds to bless the work of St Vincent de Paul, the participants will reflect with empathy and faith on the stories of those who are homeless this winter.

Here's to our embracing of God's mission! And here's thanksgiving for the goodwill of Embrace across the whole of our Greystanes Catholic Community.
