Refugees


Pope Francis' Message for today is "GOD WALKS WITH HIS PEOPLE." The Pope says that "Many migrants experience God as their traveling companion, guide and anchor of salvation".

Migrants and refugees often face the challenges of being separated from families, feeling lost, exhausted, hurt or afraid of the future. They can experience people who are unwelcoming or hostile to them in their time of vulnerability.

Jesus reminds us that those who offer merely "a cup of water to drink" will not lose their reward. Our kindness and generosity brings life to both the giver and receiver. As Pope Francis says, God not only walks with migrants and refugees, but within them and in serving the least of our brothers and sisters, we encounter Jesus himself.

As a Church walking a synodal journey together, we recognise God as our true guide and we remember God's enduring presence, walking alongside and within each one of us.

Gracious God, help us to keep walking together with our migrant brothers and sisters. Open our eyes and our hearts so that every encounter with those in need becomes an encounter with Jesus, Amen.
