# Dear friends,

#### Sr Anne

We just recently welcomed Sr Anne to be part of the parish pastoral team for 2-3 days each week. Sr Anne is a Marist Missionary Sister who has had ministry experience in contexts as different as a French parish in London to schools in Rwanda! We hope her time with us until Easter can become permanent, pending the current planning of her Marist wider Congregation internationally.

#### Fr Jobi

Then last week Fr Jobi came back from meetings and annual leave in India on Friday night - before a swift weekend move to Penrith Parish following our farewell from OLQP on Sunday morning! He has been asked to assist a ministry need of our Diocese and of St Nicholas Parish, covering a priest with other commitments over coming months.

#### **Fr Sebastian**

Now it's welcome to Fr Sebastian Thekkinieth CMI, who Bishop Vincent has appointed to OLQP from this week in a transition to life and ministry in Australia that only began last month! He comes from Kerala, the same state of southern India as Fr Jobi and is a member of the Indian founded Congregation, the Carmelites of Mary Immaculate (hence CMI after his name). They started in 1831 as a residential community of priests, combining Christian and Indian spirituality, for the purpose of contemplation and service. Fr Sebastian joined the CMI in 1997 after studies in mechanical engineering, then spent ten years in study & formation, being ordained as a priest in December 2006.

Sebastian is one of three boys in his family, with mum and dad, Mary and Francis, still living in Thrissur, Kerala. Both brothers are in India. The older one, Antony, is a Capuchin Franciscan priest - and younger bro John is married to Sherin; through whom Sebastian has a 17 year old niece, Sana and 12 year old nephew, Nevil.

Fr Sebastian was a teacher for quite some years, specialising in 'I.T.' with middle high school students and sharing in the ministry of a parish. That was in the state of Madhya Pradesh if you want to check a map. THEN, he moved to the Amazon of Brazil! Based out of the city and parish of Almeirim, his mission included being back and forth by boat to 60 communities along the Amazon River. I trust there will be some fascinating stories and learnings for us from his time in the Amazon. Fr Sebastian moved back to central India in 2020 and worked in the parish of Christ the King in a place called Guna, in the Diocese of Sagar. It's now to Australia where there are 22 other CMI priests between Syd, Bris and Melb. On your behalf and that of myself, Fr Jack and the parish team, I warmly welcome Fr Sebastian to Australia, to Parramatta Diocese and to OLOP.


