

## THANKSGIVING for new members

Right throughout the world in Catholic churches and cathedrals each Lent, many people's names are entered into what is called a 'Book of the Elect'. The names are of people who have personally chosen to be part of preparation processes towards being baptised, confirmed and welcomed to the Eucharist. They are supported through regular faith formation and friendship gatherings by members of local parishes. And then during Lent, a special ceremony in the local Cathedral presents them to the Bishop who signs the Book of the Elect to show that these people are received as ready.

This, however, is not only about what those coming into the faith community are receiving. It's also a receiving for us who already belong; a time of enormous encouragement for our own faith, that others wish to belong with us; a time to humbly realise that others are actively learning and growing in this faith and so to keep renewing our own next growth; a time to give thanks for God's grace alive at the grassroots of community, where God will bless our faithful actions to welcome many others too.

And so, with humble thanks, we celebrate 'The Elect' of our OLQP parish; Brooke, Hank, Skye and Cruz. They are seen in the photo with the Bishop and others from OLQP, including sponsors and support leaders Anne Hines and Margaret O'Connor.





# JUBILEE – a couple of thoughts at a time

As most know by now, 2025 is a 'Year of Jubilee' for the worldwide Catholic Church. Jesus himself knew of this tradition, which started many years before his Bethlehem birth in the Book of Leviticus. It's really worth looking up your bible and seeing this in Leviticus Chapter 25. If you read that chapter – and then go to the New Testament and see what Jesus announced in the Gospel of Luke Chapter 4 – you'll see that Jesus was really saying 'I am the Jubilee' ... he was announcing the bringing of liberation, mercy, healing and life.

You'll see in that ancient Chapter from Leviticus, that Jubilee started from the idea of giving the land a 'sabbath rest'! We know that the sabbath means to rest and refresh in the cycle of each week. So the idea was to rest the land every seventh year to care for it and assure it was refreshed. And then after seven sabbath years, 49, there was to be a huge effort of bringing liberation, forgiveness, justice and care in the 50th year – THE JUBILEE. The Church today doubles the frequency by having it every 25 years – and this year is it. It is a JUBILEE year – and we are called to decide and act in big and significant ways, to live this Jubilee's theme, to be PILGRIMS OF HOPE. More on Jubilee ahead ...


