am Fr. Jonathan Germinanda, 52 years old, and a priest of the Mission Society of the Philippines (MSP). I am the third and only son with my 3 sisters, two of whom are in the Philippines and another in Abu Dhabi, U.A.E. Though both my parents have passed, they remain close to our hearts as I remember them daily in my prayers. I also have a one and only niece named Therese.

I entered the seminary as a young boy of 13 years which was also the very first time that I got to be separated from my family. Nonetheless, the seminary community I came to also became a new family where I learned to nurture the desire to become a priest. Twice in the period of my seminary years, I also left and tried to discern outside if the priesthood was really my calling. Until I came to know the Mission Society of the Philippines, which awakened in me the desire to become a missionary priest.

Since my ordination to the priesthood on December 10, 2005, Australia is the third country where I was sent as a missionary. The other two of which are Papua New Guinea, then as a seminarian, and in the Netherlands, as a newly ordained priest.



Working as a missionary entail from us leaving behind our own country, family and loved ones, which can be difficult but the opportunity to meet new peoples and cultures, is a gift and opportunity not everyone is given. This is the charism of the MSP.



The MSP as a congregation of missionary priests was established by the Catholic Bishops of the Philippines as an act of gratitude to God for the gift of faith that we in the Philippines have received through the missionaries in the past. It is this sense of gratitude that we bring with us to serve the Church and fulfill the mandate of Jesus to continue to proclaim the Gospel.

Thus, it is with joy and gratitude that I come to Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish. It has been more than two weeks since I arrived in Australia from the Philippines where it was still in the heat of summer. And arriving in this country, I was met by the cold winter weather. Despite that, it is a great comfort to get to receive the warm welcome, acceptance and support from everyone, from Fr. Paul and Fr. Sebastian, the office staff and parishoners. It warms my heart and gives me the assurance that with God's grace and help, I could be of service to the parish community, my new family.

For this I say in Filipino: Maraming Salamat Po! (Thank you very much!)


